



DIZZYBUS COVID-19 GUIDELINES for DAYCARES

February 2021

TUMBLEBUS EMPLOYEE GUIDELINES

- All employees **MUST** stay home if feeling ill or have a temperature above 100 degrees Fahrenheit.
- All employees will be screened daily for COVID-19 symptoms. A yes answer to any of the following questions will result in the employee being sent home:
 - Have you been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19?
 - Are you experiencing a cough, shortness of breath or sore throat?
 - Have you had a fever in the last 48 hours?
 - Have you had loss of taste or smell?
 - Have you had vomiting or diarrhea in the last 24 hours?
- All employees will take their temperature prior to each shift and must be below 100 degrees F.
- Employees will wear face masks during all classes.
- Any employee who travels out of state, will need to quarantine for 1 week before returning to work on the Tumblebus or provide us with a negative COVID test.
- Hand Sanitizer will be placed at the front of the Tumblebus for frequent sanitizing.
- Social distancing will be in effect whenever possible. All employees should remain 6 feet from other individuals when permissible. We understand this will be difficult while teaching movement classes, so we will do our best to minimize contact and instructors will always wear a face mask.

STUDENT/DAYCARE GUIDELINES

- Tumblebus instructors will ask daycare teachers if all children have been screened prior to participating on the Tumblebus.
- All students and teachers will be required to sanitize their hands upon entering the Tumblebus.
- Dizzy's Tumblebus will require all enrolled students to be brought to the front door of the daycare so our teachers do not have to enter the daycare to collect them.

TUMBLEBUS CLASS MODIFICATIONS

- The maximum number of students in the Tumblebus will not exceed 10 children at any given time.
- Tumblebus classes may only have students from the same daycare classroom.
- Classes will be 25 minutes, with 10 minutes between classes to allow for cleaning and sanitizing.
- We will have a minimum of 50% of our windows open half-way (for safety reasons) to promote open airflow. If the weather is too windy and rainy, we will have to modify how far and how many windows we can open. Regardless, we will always have some of our windows and emergency hatches open to help with ventilation.
- We are limiting the number of daycares that a Tumblebus can visit in one day. Until restrictions are lifted in our area, you can expect that the Tumblebus will only visit 1 to 2 daycares per day. As King County moves up to Phase 3 and 4 this number could increase. We will notify your daycare if your Tumblebus will be visiting additional daycares in a single day.
- Dizzy's Tumblebus staff will conduct regular disinfecting of high-touch surfaces, equipment and common areas of the facility using disinfectant cleaning supplies according to CDC guidelines. We utilize an electrostatic sprayer between classes to assist with cleaning and disinfecting.
- All families will be required to sign the 2020-21 Season Waiver which includes COVID-19 measures.
- Dizzy's Tumblebus requires all teachers and children 5 and older wear a mask while on the Tumblebus.
- Children under 5 years old can wear face masks at their own discretion.
- Spotting during this phase will be limited to safety purposes only.

*These guidelines are subject to the guidance provided by state health departments, and the CDC. As the situation with COVID-19 continues to change and the guidance from those agencies can shift with little to no notice, Dizzy's Tumblebus reserves the right to adjust these guidelines and modifications, with or without amending these written guidelines.
